All Trains and Engines must come to full stop before passing switch to Coke Ovens at Durango, and sharp look-out kept for Switch Engines in Durango yard. Water Tanks are located at mile posts 78, 87 and 131. All trains must be under full control passing yard limit boards at Vance Junction, Dolores, Glencoe, Mancos and Durango.
